# OCTOBER 22, 2019 Saskatoon Neighbourhood: Exhibition

Show us what you like best about the Saskatoon neighbourhood known as "Exhibition". This neighbourhood is bounded by Taylor Street to the north, Victoria Avenue to the east, Circle Drive to the south, and the South Saskatchewan River to the west.

# December 10, 2019 Night Sky Photography

Images taken outdoors, at night, between dusk and dawn.

# JANUARY 21, 2020 Patterns

Submit images that display patterns. Patterns are seen in the repetition of a design element such as line, shape, colour or texture.

# **GENERAL SUBMISSION**

Clinic submission limits: 2 digitals, or 2 prints, or 1 digital and 1 print, your choice.

Categories: Altered Reality, B&W (Monochrome), Traditional (Colour). Your image can be any of these.

# GUIDELINES FOR CLINICS AND COMPETITIONS

Print size: 8" x 10" minimum, 18" x 24" maximum. These measurements include mats. Bring print images to Camera Club on the submission date.

Digital submissions are due on or before the submission date and will be submitted through the website.

Do not resize your digital images. The minimal resolution is 1280 x 800.
