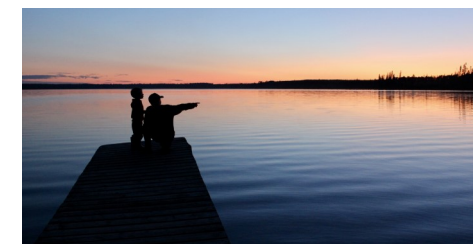

Complementary Colours

Complementary colours are those found on opposite sides of the colour wheel, such as red and green, blue and orange, yellow and purple. When juxtaposed, complementary colours make each seem brighter and more vivid, creating a powerful visual effect.

Submission limit: 2 digital images.

November 30, 2021

Product or Food Photography

A type of commercial photography that involves taking pictures of products for commercial use. The product may be an item, a food or prepared dish. Generally, though, an item in product photography is small enough to sit atop a table.

Submission limit: 2 digital images

GENERAL SUBMISSION

GUIDELINES FOR CLINICS AND COMPETITIONS

Submissions are due on or before the submission date. Instructions will be available on the website and at meetings.

Do not resize your digital image.

The minimum resolution is 1280 x 800.
