You might have lowered the camera angle to have the trees in the backrenoud behind the drinks. This might have kept the lake from being so much of a distraction.

With this much light it is hard to separate the dancers from the colorful in the background. If you can open up your aperture and increase your shutter speed, you might be able to reduce the Depth of Field enough to blur the background.
