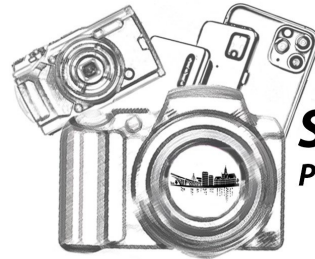

Before considering an image to submit to a Review or Competition, please go to our Club's or CAPA's website to read the subject matter guidelines for each one or risk disqualification or an unfavourable review.

Submissions are due on or before the submission deadline. Submission instructions will be available on the website and at meetings.

All submissions are done online through our Club's website submission process.

Do not resize your digital image.

The minimum resolution is 1280 x 800.

Submit full-size resolution images if you can.

Prints are only considered for the Year End Competition.

Notes on Competition Judging

CAPA - digital images will be evaluated by 3 to 9 CAPA judges and given a numerical score only.

Fall & Winter Competitions - digital images will be evaluated by one **PSA** judge and given a numerical score with comments.

Photo Presentation and Year End - will be judged by three of local experienced photographers and given a numerical score and comments.
